



The Board agreed to continue current policies regarding Covid: small groups may meet indoors without masks, provided that all participants are comfortable and that mask-wearing is always respected.

The Board received a report from the governance team. Recommendations were:

- -We need an acting President for legal purposes by July 1;
- -Consider reducing the size of the Board and requiring fewer meetings;
- -Presidential and other Board responsibilities for the coming year can be discussed and divided up at the July Board Meeting.

The Board approved compensation packages for Rev. Jane and Stephen.

The operating budget for the 2022/23 church year was approved.

Update From the Afghan Refugee Resettlement Team

The work of the Afghan Refugee Resettlement Team had been unfolding quickly! Here is a summary of what has been happening and how you can help.

Recently <u>Luminus Network for New Americans</u> directed us to a young Afghani couple, and their 20-month-old son, where we were able to deliver a few pieces of furniture, as well as some kitchen items that they needed. The family lives in North Bethesda. This connection led to conversations with the family, and we became aware of some of their needs and the great difficulties in meeting them.

To date, in addition to the furniture and kitchen items, we have been able to provide them with clothing, a cell phone, a car seat, table cloths and a clock. We are currently assisting the father in getting a US driver's license. The family is very kind and generously serves us delicious snacks or meals whenever we have been to their home to assist them.

Meeting this family, and becoming aware of their needs, has opened the door to some opportunities for giving that can only be met with the combined efforts of the members and friends of the Channing community.

This family is looking for a sewing machine: From what we understand, the mother is very good at sewing, and the sewing machine might be able to play a role in a future source of income. It needs to be in good working order, preferably having undergone a recent "tune-up" at a sewing store. The family currently cannot transport it to the store for repairs, nor do they have the means to pay for any needed repairs.

The family would also benefit from having a computer.

At this time, there is no more room in the storage unit for furniture, although we could fit a few more boxes of household goods and kitchen things. We will contact Luminus about connecting us with additional families who need furniture. We'll update you about the things the new families need, how to get them to us, and other relevant details as things develop.

Donations do not have to be new, but they should be clean, in good shape, and not in need of any repairs. Everything we have donated to this family, except the car seat, has been second-hand. They are grateful for everything.
